

Community Bikes Application

Community Bikes collects and reconditions donated bicycles and places them, along with a helmet and lock, with those who would love to have a bike, but for whom buying one would be a hardship. To be eligible to receive a bike, *recipients must be eligible for Medicaid, SNAP, SSI or other cash assistance, or must have other demonstrated need.* Bikes are available to children and adults of all ages and sizes. If you are unsure about eligibility, please contact us (see below).
