



CODE BLUE: WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

If you are homeless and have no shelter:

Executive order 151 states in part that – during the dates to include November 1 to March 31 or any other periods when the temperature is below freezing or inclement weather conditions. If you are without shelter you can access shelter and support services through the Department of Social Services.

Transportation can be provided by local law enforcement to DSS if there is none available. All persons will be screened to determine if other resources are available to them.

Warming sites are also available. Stop in during normal business hours for access to some refreshments, a telephone as well as to receive hygiene and cold weather supplies. See side bar for a list of Warming Site locations.
